To be awarded the Diploma of Early Childhood Education and Care, a total of 28 units (23 core and 5 elective) of competency must be completed.

COURSE DURATION

12 Months full time or 18 months part time

A typical study program is three days per week supplemented by work placement. Or two days per week part time

Work placement

You are required to undertake a total of 240 hours of supervised placement in a regulated children's services Centre. These hours can be completed in one or more centres over a mutually agreed time frame with the centre/s that have agreed to provide you with placement.

Eligibility for Certificate 3 Guarantee funding
